

## UnbelEAFable!

Find a leaf (or leaves) and trace it over and over again in the space above.

Use "popart" colours to fill them in!



**Hint:** Think of this as creating wallpaper! Not sure what "pop art" colours are? Look it up and learn about the fun, bold hues!

Expressionist drawings! Excited Confused Silly! Try and create the expression written below the face shape!



**Hint:** Think about how the shape of the mouth and the direction of the eyebrow lines make all the difference in each expression. This is a great excercise that shows you how impactful a simple line can be in art!

Create a scene using one really BIG animal (like an elephant) and one really small animal (like a mouse), BUT reverse them. So, the mouse is really big and the elephant is very small!



**Hint:** This excercise is a fun way to show you what a difference scale (or size) makes in art when you compare two objects. By playing with the scale, you can change something from realistic to silly! Choose two animals that you think will be the most fun to draw!
