The candidate will be responsible for the set-up of activities, communicating with participants, assisting with the delivery of programs, and any mandated Covid-19 safety measures and implementation. Other responsibilities include assisting with research into and delivering children/youth art activities, supervising children's lunch and snack breaks, assisting in brainstorming strategies and skills for developing summer art camp programming. This will include preparing the studio space, preparing materials for projects, overseeing camper check and check out, helping with children's art projects, and supervising children's lunch and snack breaks. Opportunities to work on digital promotions and online registration will also be provided.

The ideal candidate has excellent communication, teamwork and problem-solving skills, a positive attitude and eagerness to participate in art and Gallery activities.
